- Briefing** There will be a briefing in front of the club house at 12:30
- Official Notice Board** A white board in front of the club will be used to communicate with competitors
- Starting Line** The start line will be specified on the day and may be:
- Fortuna near the entrance to the river
 - Baverstock
 - Club Line
- Starts** Single start for all classes.
- Courses** The course will have relatively short legs. It will be identified
- At the briefing
 - On the Official Notice Board and/or the side of the committee boat.
- Warning Signal** 5 Minutes before the start (RRS 26 signals at 5,4,1 start). The start will be not before 13:30am.
- Finishing** The finishing line will be the same as the starting line.
- Competitors may be finished on any lap. Results will be based on lap timed handicap.
 - The Race Officer may, at his discretion, assign any boat that is racing, a finishing time and number of laps or a position.

Class Groupings, start sequence and Flags

The single start will use code flag A as the warning signal.

Scoring Competitors qualify for the Club Regatta Series by:

- Completing a number of fully timed laps in both Race 1 & Race 2.
- Competitors who are assigned finishing positions are not able to complete the Club Regatta Series.

Target time for most boats 30 Minutes

Time Limit 45 Minutes
