**Water bottles:** There are opportunities to refill water bottles next to the LTSC changing rooms entrance or in the RLymYC Slipway Lounge.

**Event boat park:** a section of the Bath Road field will be cordoned off for visiting dinghies and single trailers during the event. Multi-stackers need to be taken out of the car park – marshals will explain on arrival. RS800's may be berthed at LTSC depending on height restrictions accessing the field. **Registration:** Will be downstairs at RLymYC.

**Directions to the Clubs:** Check traffic websites for heavy traffic into Lyndhurst from the M27; it is recommended that you travel via Beaulieu (from the East) or Burley (from the West).

**Car Parking:** The Bath Road Car Park, owned and operated by New Forest District Council, is pay and display, with cash, card or online payment via RingGo (location 2560). **Only the machine nearest the entrance accepts card payments.** The charging period all year is 06:00 to 22:00. Please note that overnight camping/sleeping is not permitted. There are two electric charging points in the car park. We recommend you download the RingGo app before you arrive as card payment can often be problematic. There is some free parking on the local streets.

**Slipway:** The slipway is public and **must be kept clear** for the RNLI lifeboat and other users. In particular keep out of the yellow hatched area until instructed to pass through it by the Beach Master. Also please keep clear of the red RNLI parking spaces.

**Trolleys:** At registration you will be given a trolley label - please attach this to your trolley before launch. On launching follow the guidance of the Beach Master.

**Ferries:** The Wightlink ferries operate between Lymington and Yarmouth and have right of way at all times. Stay at least 100m away from the bow of the ferry when it is moving, any closer and you cannot be seen by the ferry captain. The ferry will not stop for you and cannot change course while in the river channel. Keep to the edge of the river out of the channel and respond to directions from the coach/safety RIB at all times!

**Lymington:** Lymington is a wonderful place to visit! The town is steeped in rich history: its sheltered position on the western bank of the beautiful Lymington river has made it an important settlement since the Iron Age. For many years Lymingtonians have made their living from the sea or the river - as boatbuilders, fishermen, sailors and in past centuries as salt workers and even smugglers! Today Lymington is an internationally famous yachting centre. If you are not sailing there is plenty to do – just ask a local!

**Nearby Chandleries:** Nick Cox, King's Saltern Road; Force 4, Bath Road. Both are within a 10-minute walk.
